POSITION: DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING

NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: 1

DESCRIPTION:

This residency is a 4-year (48 months), full time, graduate program of 108 credits, the majority of which are obtained during supervised clinical training. A diploma of specialized studies (D.E.S.) is awarded upon completion of the program. The resident will spend most of his/her intensive clinical training in the field of veterinary diagnostic imaging. The resident will be exposed to various diagnostic imaging modalities available in our facility including radiology, ultrasound, computed tomography, scintigraphy and magnetic resonance imaging in order to meet the requirements of the American College of Veterinary Radiology. The resident will participate in the diagnostic imaging examination of inpatients, emergency and hospitalized veterinary patients. The resident is required to complete a clinical research project and participate in the daily supervision of undergraduate students in diagnostic imaging. He (she) may also participate in the teaching laboratories of junior veterinary students. The resident will also be responsible for emergency imaging duty for no more than one out of three weeks. All residents are entitled to three weeks of vacation per year, which are determined by the program director and the clinical service to which the student is attached according to the needs of the service. The resident who is not required to be on emergency duty is entitled to the standard set of statutory holidays as the professors. Any veterinary medical activity performed outside the residency program must be declared to the student's program director and to the associate dean for clinical training and continuing education. A resident wishing to pursue a master's program may avail himself/herself of this privilege after satisfactory completion of the first year upon approval of the program director and department chair.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Doctor in Veterinary Medicine (DVM) or the equivalent
- Has recently completed an internship or has an equivalent experience
- Licensing from the Ordre des Médecins Vétérinaires du Québec (Quebec's Veterinary Medical Board) before beginning the program
- Working knowledge of French (would need to be learnt if no knowledge prior to the start of the residency)

TUITION FEES (Amounts shown are in Canadian currency):

- Landed immigrants and Canadian citizens living in Quebec, French citizens, Francophone Belgian citizens : +/- \$4,600 / year
- Landed immigrants and Canadian citizens not living in Quebec : +/- \$11,500 / year
- Other nationalities : +/- \$16,200 / year

REMUNERATION:

- \$27,000 /1st year

To these amounts are added 3.6 % for benefits and 3 % for the payment of public holidays.

* Continuation of the program to a second, third and fourth year depends on the mutual satisfaction of the resident and the Faculty.

The resident is also allotted a total amount of \$3,000 to attend two conferences in his specialty during his/her program (maximum amount per activity: \$2,000)
