#### POSITION: SPECIALIZED INTERNSHIP IN EMERGENCY AND CRITICAL CARE

NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: 3 (This number may vary according to budget availability.)

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

This internship in veterinary clinical sciences is an intensive clinical training program in emergency and critical care of 12 months (53 weeks) duration. A certificate is awarded upon completion of the program. The program includes clinical training and participation in clinical teaching rounds and labs. Interns will work in the Centre Hospitalier Universitaire Vétérinaire (CHUV) and will be supervised by clinicians, professors and the program coordinator. This internship prepares the candidate for a residency program or working in emergency. The intern will be expected to work day, evening, night and weekend shifts, on a rotating basis and is expected to carry out a clinical research project and participate in daily supervision of students and rotating interns. Interns are eligible for three non-consecutive vacation weeks determined by the program director. Any professional activities performed outside the internship program must be declared to the Vice dean of clinical studies.

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM) or equivalent
- · Have recently completed an internship or equivalent clinical experience (2 years)
- License from the Ordre des Médecins Vétérinaires du Québec before starting the program
- Internship in French

## **TUITION FEES (Amounts shown are in Canadian currency):**

- Quebec, Canadian outside Quebec: On average \$6,665 for the duration of training
- French/French-speaking Belgian students: On average \$7,521 for the duration of training
- International students: On average \$24,962 for the duration of training, including the UdeM exemption scholarship

# REMUNERATION: The candidate receives \$ 19 500 for 53 weeks. To these amounts are added 1 287 \$ (3.6 % for the payment of public holidays and 3 % for benefits).

A 2% contribution of gross salary will be deducted for union dues. Salary and conditions will follow the agreements stipulated in the collective agreement.

The specialized intern is also allotted a total amount of \$500 to attend one conference in his specialty during his/her program.

Intern responsibilities:

- (1) Clinical activity and participation in out-of-hour and holiday duties (emergency surgeries and patient care) based on the clinical schedule;
- (2) Clinical teaching duties (participation in student teaching rounds and laboratories);
- (3) Participation in research activities and presentation of a seminar will be encouraged.
