## Research project in French-speaking Belgium (Wallonia-Brussels)

This [programme](#) provides \$6,000 for graduate students, and postdoctoral fellows in Canada to conduct 12–24-week research projects at universities in French-speaking Belgium (Wallonia-Brussels Federation).

Applications are done via MITACS only.

<b>Joint WBI/Mitacs Globalink Research Award</b>	
<b>Target</b>	Doctoral student or postdoctoral fellow wishing to undertake a research project in French-speaking Belgium
<b>Research themes</b>	Open to all disciplines
<b>Duration</b>	<b>Short-term research projects</b> 3 to 6 months (non-renewable)
<b>Funding</b>	<p>\$6,000 allowance. Funding is based on a project duration of 12 weeks, though projects durations of up to 24 weeks are acceptable. Applicants are encouraged to seek support from other funding sources for longer durations and use prudence when allocating funds to travel and accommodations.</p> <p>Approved recipients will receive funds to support participant travel and accommodation expenses, research-related expenses, and stipend.</p>
<b>Application deadlines</b>	<b>Open-ended application process</b> , until the limit of 10 funded projects per year is met.

Applications are done via WBI only.

<b>Joint WBI/Mitacs Mitacs Globalink Research Award</b>	
<b>Target</b>	Doctoral student or postdoctoral researcher wishing to undertake a research project in Canada
<b>Research themes</b>	Open to all disciplines
<b>Duration</b>	<b>Short-term research projects</b> 3 to 6 months (non-renewable)
<b>Funding</b>	\$6,000 allowance. Funding is based on a project duration of 12 weeks, though projects durations of up to 24 weeks are acceptable. Applicants are encouraged to seek support from other funding sources for longer durations and use prudence when allocating funds to travel and accommodations.  Approved recipients will receive funds to support participant travel and accommodation expenses, research-related expenses, and stipend.
<b>Application deadlines</b>	- for a <b>stay between February and May</b> : no later than the <b>preceding 1<sup>st</sup> of October</b> - for a <b>stay between June and September</b> : no later than the <b>preceding 1<sup>st</sup> of February</b> - for a <b>stay between October and January</b> (starting the 1 <sup>st</sup> of November at the latest) : no later than the <b>preceding 1<sup>st</sup> of May</b>  A maximum of 10 research projects will be funded per year.
