MI-CAT(C) Total Score Calculation Refer to Table 1 rows **A** and **B**, and Table 2 rows **C** and **D**. Total score range is 0-1. B+C = A+B+C+D

Example:

Fluffy has 10 Yes (A), 7 No (B), and 1 unanswered items in Table 1. She has 6 Yes (C), 10 No (D), 3 Don't Know/Does Not Apply, and 1 unanswered items in Table 2. Score calculation:

(7+6)/(10+7+6+10) = 13/33 = 0.39 = 39%
